## NOTICE TO FILE COMPANY ANNUAL RETURNS

---

Sections 132 and 133 of the Companies Act, 2012 require companies to file annual returns with the Registrar of Companies. Where a company fails to file returns, company officers are liable to a default fine and where such default continues for a period of five years, the Registrar of Companies may strike the company off the register.

Notice is hereby given to all companies to comply with their legal obligation to file all outstanding annual returns by visiting our website **[www.ursb.go.ug](http://www.ursb.go.ug)**, click the e-services tab, select business registration and choose annual returns filing.

Companies that fail to file annual returns for a period of five (5) years or more are required to file a statement of solvency and show cause why they should not be struck off the register within sixty (60) days from the date of this notice.
